FEATURED CUSTOMER: CHRISTIAN HEALTH ASSOCIATION OF KENYA (CHAK)



In this issue of *The Update*, we are featuring our new customer from Africa, Christian Health Association of Kenya (CHAK). Joseph Rugut, the Electrical and X-Ray Engineer at CHAK was delighted to share information about his organization with us.

What is the history of CHAK?

CHAK is a leading national Faith Based Organization (FBO) of Protestant churches' health facilities and programs located throughout Kenya. CHAK was first established in 1946 with a primary focus on providing and promoting quality health care access across the nation. The organization is comprised of various health facilities and member programs, governance organs including a regional structure and the Secretariat situated in Nairobi.

What does Joseph Rugut's part of the organization do?

Joseph and his team's division of CHAK focuses on Radiation Safety. They source, install and maintain radiology-related equipment in FBO, non-profits and some public facilities in Kenya. They facilitate calibration and certifications for these different entities. Their team also administers quality assurance and control protocols and Radiation Safety Assessment (RSA) to meet local and international standards. Lastly, they provide trainings for their colleagues and members of CHAK throughout the various locations in Kenya.

How did CHAK first learn about Dosimetrics and the BeOSL System?

CHAK first learned about Dosimetrics at an IAEA conference in Vienna in 2016. Reiner introduced Joseph and his team to the BeOSL System and since then they have always had an interest in having one of their own. Finally, at the beginning of this year, Joseph and his team received their BeOSL System through a cooperation with a German-based organization.
